Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – May 9, 2022

- Council adopted:
 - Financial Plan Bylaw No. 2014, 2022. Bylaw 2014 sets out the five-year financial plan for the District of Kitimat.
 - Tax Rates Bylaw No. 2015, 2022. Bylaw 2015 sets out the tax rates by property classification for 2022.
 - Residential Flat Tax Rate Amendment Bylaw No. 2016, 2022. Bylaw No. 2016 sets out the flat tax rate for 2022.

- Council approved a Development Variance Permit Application at 35 Dunn Street to vary the maximum building height from 4.9 meters (16 feet) to 6.1 meters (20 feet) as well as vary the requirement of principal building being equal to or taller than the accessory building in the R2-A Two Family Residential Zone.
- Council approved a Temporary Use Application to allow installation and operation of a portable concrete production plant at 2150 Forest Avenue.
- Council approved the cancellation of the June 6, September 9 and October 17, 2022 Regular Meetings of Council due to conflicts with other events.
- Council directed staff to provide a letter of support for the Regional District of Kitimat Stikine's application to the Northern Development Initiative Trust's Northern Health Communities Fund for the creation of a labour market study and to further contribute \$10,000 towards the study.
