



# Notes from Council

## Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – May 30, 2022

- Council rescinded third reading of Signs Amendment Bylaw No. 2017, 2022 and requested staff clarify the section on distance between election signs and bring the bylaw back for further consideration.

Bylaw No. 2017, 2022 will be brought back for Council consideration of third reading on June 13, 2022.

- Council received for information, discussion, and feedback the Draft Nechako Centre Concept Plan. Further public engagement is being planned for late summer 2022.
- Council approved the 24-Hour Daycare Project budget be set at \$3,978,100.
- Council approved the use of Riverlodge Field 2 for the landing and take-off spot for helicopters for the Canada Day Event and directed staff to issue a letter of support.
- Council directed staff to refer the issue of managing access to the Riverlodge Sports Field to the Leisure Services Advisory Commission to provide a recommendation for Council consideration.
- Council approved the 2021 Financial Statements.
- Council approved the draft 2021 Annual Report for public comment. The 2021 Annual Report will be brought back to Council on June 20, 2022 for consideration of approval.
