Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – June 20, 2022

- Council received a presentation from David Johnston regarding the increased harassment and violence in leash off areas for dogs.
- Council adopted Signs Amendment Bylaw No. 2017, 2022. Bylaw No. 2017, 2022 includes changes to election signs.
- Council adopted Election Amendment Bylaw No. 2019, 2022. Bylaw No. 2019 includes amendments to the *Kitimat Municipal Code* with respect to elections including special voting opportunities, mail ballot procedures, and use of a run-off election in the event of a tie.
- Council approved the 2022-2023 Annual Operating Agreement with BC Transit.
- Council approved the 2021 Annual Report and 2021 Financial Statements. The Annual Report and Financial Statements are available on the District website [here](#).
- Council approved the 2021 Statement of Financial Information and are located on the District website [here](#).
- Council directed staff to enter into the Local Government Climate Action Program. The program will provide predictable, annual and long-term funding to support the District's local climate initiatives.
- Council cancelled the 4 July 2022 Regular Meeting of Council.
- Council directed staff to draft a bylaw amending the Leisure Services Department Fee Schedule. The bylaw will be brought forward for consideration of first three readings and adoption in July.
- Council approved a request from Special Olympics to for free access to some Leisure Services facilities.
- Council approved no charge use of Riverlodge Soccer Fields for the Men's Soccer League.
- Council directed staff to issue a letter of support for Whitecourt's resolution to the Federation of Canadian Municipalities (FCM) in support of Canadian consumption of Canadian oil and gas resources.
