



# Notes from Council

## Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – July 18, 2022

- Council received a presentation from the Kitimat Heritage Group and Kiwanis Club regarding the Kitimat Heritage Report and the Kiwanis clock at Centre City Mall.
- Council gave first three readings to Leisure Services Fees and Charges Amendment Bylaw No. 2020, 2022. The Bylaw will be brought back for Council consideration for adoption at the July 25, 2022 meeting. Bylaw 2020 proposed to amend the fees and charges for leisure services activities and facilities and, if adopted, would take effect September 1, 2022.
- Council set a Public Hearing date of Tuesday, September 6, 2022 at 7:00 p.m. for the Downtown Revitalization Area Official Community Plan Amendment Bylaw No. 2013, 2022. Public Notice will be issued and available on the District of Kitimat website [here](#).
- Council approved a Development Variance Permit application at 56 Meldrum Street to vary the height of the accessory structure/building from 4.9 m to 6.1 m (16 feet to 20 feet).
- Council endorsed the participation of the District of Kitimat in the First Nation-Municipal Community Economic Development Initiative (CEDI). CEDI supports the building of respectful and equitable partnerships between First Nations and neighbouring municipalities and develops capacity for long-term planning for joint community economic development and land use.
- Council approved a letter of support to LNG Canada for the Sumgas Creek Habitat / Offsetting Restoration Enhancement Project and directed Staff to negotiate an access agreement over Sumgas Creek. A number of conditions were provided by Council for staff to consider when negotiating the agreement.
