



# Notes from Council

## Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – August 2, 2022

- Council received a presentation from Leisl Kaberry regarding the Restorative Justice Program and how it is used in the local schools and a presentation from S/Sgt Graham Morgan on the April and May 2022 monthly policing reports.
- Council approved a development permit application for a multi-family residential development at Wakita and Nalabila.
- Council approved free transit for Route 1 – Whitesail, Route 2 – Nechako, Route 3 – Kildala, and HandyDART for General Voting Day on Saturday, October 15, 2022.
- Council received a copy of correspondence from the Ministry of Environment and Climate Change Strategy regarding Rio Tinto's air monitoring station in the Service Centre and directed staff to send a letter to the Ministry affirming the District's support for a monitoring station in Service Centre, that the District supports all air quality data being considered and that it not be limited to Rio Tinto's "normal operations", and that the same air quality standard be applied in the Service Centre as the rest of Kitimat.
