



Notes from Council

Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – November 21, 2022

- Council gave first three readings to District of Kitimat Council Remuneration Bylaw No. 2021, 2022. Council considers their remuneration rates annually as per a policy adopted by Council. The policy considers any increase or decrease to the Consumer Price Index (Inflation) when setting any changes to remuneration. Bylaw No. 2021 proposes a 3% increase to the 2022 rates and would take effect on January 1, 2023. Council will consider adoption of Bylaw No. 2021 at the December 5, 2022, meeting of Council.
- Council approved amendments to a Development Permit issued to IAG Enterprises on August 2, 2022, for a development located at Wakita and Nalabila. The landscape plan is amended and the landscaping letter of credit was reduced from \$183,538.20 to \$100,000. The amended development permit will be subject to the other conditions of the development permit issued on August 2, 2022.
- Council approved the schedule of Regular meetings for 2023. The schedule is available on the District of Kitimat website [here](#).
- Council approved a grant application to the Kitimat Ice Demons in the amount of \$4,500 which will be applied to ice rental fees for the 2022/2023 season.
- Council approved a grant application to Unifor 2300 for their annual Christmas party.
- Council received correspondence from Shames Mountain for a request for funding towards the purchase and installation of solar energy infrastructure for an off-grid solar project at Shames Mountain and referred the request to the 2023 budget discussions.
