Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – January 9, 2023

- Council directed staff to send a letter to BC’s Chief Medical Officer requesting that the province vaccine mandate for health care workers be ended.
- Council received a request for comment from the Ministry of Energy, Mines and Low Carbon Innovation for an application by JHW: Hirsch Creek Pit. Council directed staff to report back on any requirements for rezoning of the property noted in the application. Staff will report back at a future meeting of Council.
- Council continued with the 2023 budget discussions.
