Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – January 16, 2023

- Council received a presentation from the Kitimat RCMP Detachment on the October, November, and December 2022 monthly policing reports.
- Council adopted 2023 Revenue Anticipation Borrowing Bylaw No. 2022, 2023.
- Council provided comment to the Ministry of Energy, Mines and Low Carbon Innovation with respect to JHW Construction's application to operate a quarry at the JHW Hirsch Creek Pit.
- Council provided comment to the Ministry of Forests with respect to the application by LNG Canada and Rio Tinto Alcan for their industrial land lease and sale.
- Council continued with the 2023 budget discussions.

The following capital projects received early approval by Council for 2023. These projects are multi-year projects currently in progress. Granting of early approval will keep these projects on track for completion within their proposed timelines:
