



# Notes from Council

## Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – February 6, 2023

- Council received a presentation from BC Transit on an overview of transit services in Kitimat and BC Transit initiatives around the province.
- Council received a presentation on the joint project of Cedar LNG and Coastal Gaslink Pipeline Ltd.
- Council gave first three readings to Restriction of Use of the Illegal Substance – Subsection 56(1) Class Exemption Bylaw No. 2023, 2023. The Bylaw proposes to restrict the area of usage of illegal substances exempted under Subsection 56(1) Class Exemption for Adults in the Province of British Columbia to possess small amounts of Opioids, Cocaine, Methamphetamine and MDMA issued by the Federal Minister of Health effective January 31, 2023. Bylaw No. 2023 will be brought forward for Council consideration of adoption at a future meeting of Council.
- Council approved a development permit in the Downtown Revitalization Area to allow updates to signage to Co-op at 884 South Lahakas Boulevard (formerly the Husky Gas Station).
- Council received a report regarding the deadline to submit resolutions to the North Central Local Government Association (NCLGA) for consideration during their Annual General Meeting. Resolutions endorsed by the NCLGA are forwarded for consideration during the Union of BC Municipalities (UBCM) Annual General Meeting in September.
- Council authorized expenses for members of Council to attend the UBCM Housing Summit in Vancouver.
- Council received for information a report regarding proposed changes to the terms of reference of the Energy Emissions and Solid Waste Advisory Committee.
- Council will begin to receive periodic updates from the Finance, Public Works, Engineering and Leisure Services Department. An update from Leisure Services is expected in March.
