Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – February 21, 2023

- Council received a presentation regarding Green Shirt Day and directed staff to light up Tamitik and other District facilities green on April 7, 2023. Green Shirt Day is in honour of the life of Humboldt Bronco's player Logan Boulet and to raise awareness for Canadians to become organ donors.
- Council received a presentation regarding an auto-belay top-rope climbing wall grant application by a local non-profit. Council issued a letter of support for the application of the grant.
- Council adopted Restriction of Use of the Illegal Substance – Subsection 56(1) Class Exemption Bylaw No. 2023, 2023. The Bylaw restricts the area of usage of illegal substances exempted under Subsection 56(1) Class Exemption for Adults in the Province of British Columbia to possess small amounts of Opioids, Cocaine, Methamphetamine and MDMA issued by the Federal Minister of Health effective January 31, 2023.
- Council will be putting forward a resolution for consideration at the North Central Local Government Association's Annual General Meeting for the province to reconsider their timelines for sales of electric vehicles in British Columbia.

- Council received a presentation from staff regarding an update on the Strawberry Meadows Neighbourhood Plan project. Council approved five major themes and action items for staff.
