Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – March 6, 2023

- Council reconsidered a previous motion which was to forward a resolution to the North Central Local Government Association for consideration at their Annual General Meeting. The resolution submitted was amended and will be submitted to the NCLGA for consideration. Council also approved a resolution for consideration by the NCLGA regarding the current provincial vaccine mandate.
- Council received for information a report on the Community Recognition of Excellence program. The program recognizes youth who have provided notable volunteer service to the community and those who distinguish themselves as citizens within our community. - Council directed staff to send a letter to the Minister of Health supporting the replacement of the Bulkley Valley District Hospital in Smithers.
