Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – March 13, 2023

- Council received a presentation from the District Grant Writer highlighting the District and community grant successes over the last three years.

Did you know that over the last six years, there has been over \$13M received in grants and our grant writer has a 75% success rate on grant applications!

- Council considered a Council Correspondence Policy which outlines how staff will manage correspondence to Council. The policy will be brought forward at a future meeting of Council for consideration of approval.
- Council approved an application to the UBCM Poverty Reduction Planning and Action Grant Program, Stream 2. If successful, the grant would support an educational and marketing program to destigmatize the issues around homelessness and poverty. This program aligns with recommendations from the Kitimat Poverty Reduction Strategy presented to Council on August 22, 2022.
