



Notes from Council

Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – March 20, 2023

- Council received a presentation from the Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion Project Team on their Analysis of the Core Policy Documents in the District of Kitimat. Council directed that this report be included for discussion at a strategic planning session.
- Council approved a three-year Temporary Use Permit for J. Oviatt Contracting to:
 - stockpiling logs, and firewood acquired from the clearing of lots from Strawberry Meadows;
 - processing topsoil acquired from the construction of the road to Minette Bay West Park;
 - storing raw topsoil, masonry sand and silt;
 - storing hog fuel, rig mats, a portable bridge and a portable sawmill;
 - utilizing Forced Air Log/Wood Burning Pit on site;
 - storage area for drying wood;
 - to sell topsoil;
 - snow hauling primarily from Civeo Sitka Lodge, but also from other off-site locations within the District, and accessing the subject site through Loganberry Ave;
 - allowing four workers for processing the topsoil- 3 weeks per year; two site crews for burning the wood- 2 weeks per year; one person for topsoil sales; one person for loading topsoil in truck; one person for snow storage; a site foreperson; and storing a machine for organizing the snow storage.
- Council approved a grant application to the UBCM Emergency Operations Centres and Training Program to purchase monitors, carts, and tables to be used in the Emergency Operations Centres. These items would be used during Emergency Operation education, training exercises, and in the event of an actual emergency.
