



# Notes from Council

## Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – April 3, 2023

- Council approved a resolution on the provincial vaccine mandate to be forwarded to the North Central Local Government Association for consideration at their Annual General Meeting.
- Council issued a comment to the Ministry of Forests, Lands, and Natural Resource Operations on an amendment to a WindPower Investigative Licence by Sea Breeze Power Corp. The investigative licence would allow Sea Breeze Power Corp to undertake assessments, studies, site investigations, and installation of up to five meteorological towers to determine viability for a wind power project (wind farm) in the area of Clague Mountain. One meteorological tower is proposed within the District of Kitimat boundaries.
- Council received for consideration a development variance permit request for 26 Currie Street to permit a rear yard setback of 4.7m from the required 7.5m for extending a cantilever deck.

Public notice will be issued and the application will be considered by Council at a future meeting. Information on the application can be found at the District website [here](#).

- Council approved an amendment to the Leisure Access Program to include ten no charge access passes to District facilities by persons who are recommended by the Physiotherapy Department of the Kitimat General Hospital. This will support persons in their pre-op or post-op recovery.
- Council directed staff to report back on options for on and off leash areas for Hirsch Creek Park.
- Council received an update on the facilities, programming, and staffing of the Leisure Services Department
