Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – May 15, 2023

Regular Meeting of Council

- Council approved the 2023/24 Annual Operating Agreement with BC Transit.
- Following a presentation from representatives of BC Transit, Council approved in principle the BC Transit Future Service Plan (TFSP). The plan sets out the local service and infrastructure priorities for transit services in Kitimat. The TFSP can be found on the District website [here](#).
- Council received three guest flag requests for June. For June, the following guest flags will be flown at the Firehall from sunrise to sunset as follows:
 - Pride Flag in recognition of Pride Month from June 1 to June 7
 - Portuguese Flag in recognition of Portuguese Heritage Month from June 8 to June 14
 - Flag of the Philippines in recognition of Filipino Heritage Month from June 15 to June 21

Committee of the Whole

- Council directed staff to report back with a bylaw for Council consideration amending the on leash areas of Hirsch Creek Park to include the campsites, covered area, picnic area, roadways, and shorter trail by picnic tables and shelter. The sports field, beach areas and longer looped trail will remain off leash. A bylaw will be brought forward for Council consideration at a future meeting of Council.
- Council directed staff to report back with a bylaw for the proposed Leisure Services fee scheduled for 2023/24. The fee schedule sets out user fees for the District's recreational facilities. The bylaw will be brought forward for Council consideration at a future meeting of Council.
- Council directed staff to bring back the Communications Policy for consideration of adoption. The policy is created to ensure the purpose and general process of communications by the District of Kitimat is effectively explained and outline. The policy will be brought forward for consideration of adoption at a future meeting of Council.
