Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – June 5, 2023

- Council received a presentation from BC Hydro regarding the North Coast Electrification – Glenannan to Terrace Transmission Project.
- Council received a presentation from the RCMP, Kitimat Detachment regarding the March and April monthly policing reports.
- Council gave first and second reading to C1 City Centre Zone Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 2032, 2023. Bylaw No. 2032, 2023 would rezone the lowest level of 311 City Centre to allow mini-storage as a use. Public Notice will be issued and referred to the Advisory Planning Commission. A Public Hearing was scheduled for Tuesday, July 4, 2023 at 7:00 p.m.

- Council approved the joint application with the Haisla Nation to the 2023 UBCM Community Emergency Preparedness Fund Extreme Temperature Risk Mapping, Assessment and Planning Grant. If successful, the grant would provide \$60,000 to develop plans for extreme heat events.
- Council approved the draft Code of Conduct Policy C-35 which regulates the conduct of members of the District of Kitimat including members of Council and persons appointed to Committees. The policy will be brought back to Council for consideration of approval at a future meeting.
- Council approved the Draft 2022 Annual Report for public inspection and comment. Council will consider approval of the 2022 Annual Report at the June 26, 2023 Special Meeting of Council. The Draft 2022 Annual Report is available for inspection at Municipal Hall or on our website [here](#).
