Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – June 19, 2023

- Council considered Off Leash Areas for Animals Bylaw No. 2031, 2023. An amendment to include the Hirsch Creek North Trail as off leash was made and Bylaw No. 2031, 2023 was given three readings. Council will consider adoption of this bylaw at the June 26, 2023, meeting of Council.
- Council received a presentation regarding the Community Wildfire Resiliency Plan (CWRP). The Plan will be brought back to a future Committee of the Whole meeting for further discussion by Council. You can find the CWRP on the District website [here](#).
- Council approved for consideration a Development Variance Permit Application for 82 Meldrum. The application is to vary the height of an accessory structure from 4.9 metres to 6.1 metres (16 feet to 20 feet). Public Notice will be posted to the District website and notice boards, and mailed to properties within 30 metres of 82 Meldrum. - Council will continue to work with the Mountain Elizabeth Cycling Association (MECA) on completing the Haisla Hill and developing future cycling trails in the community. A report will be brought back to a future meeting regarding parking options and pedestrian access for the Haisla Hills cycling trails.
- Council approved District of Kitimat Communications Policy (C-34). The policy outlines communications generally by the District of Kitimat and includes the Language Style Guide and Brand Guidelines which sets out the manner in which the District communicates with the public. - Council approved a request from the Kitimat Army Cadets to use the District of Kitimat logo on their flag.
- Council directed a report be brought back with options to consider construction of a rock-climbing wall.
- Council directed a report be brought back with options to consider development of paths in the forested area near Nechako Elementary School.
