## Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – June 26, 2023

### Committee of the Whole

- Council directed that the 2023-2026 Strategic Plan be brought back to a Regular Meeting of Council for consideration of approval.

### Special Meeting of Council

- Council adopted Off Leash Areas for Animals Bylaw No. 2031, 2023. The bylaw sets out the areas within the District that are off leash areas for dogs. You can find more information about off leash areas [here](#).
- Council rescinded first two readings of the C1 Centre City Zone Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 2032, 2023 given on June 5, 2023 and cancelled the public hearing scheduled for July 4, 2023.
- Amendments were considered and Council gave first and second reading to C1 City Centre Zone Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 2032, 2023. Bylaw No. 2032, 2023 would rezone the lowest level of 311 City Centre to allow mini-storage as a use. A Public Hearing is scheduled for Monday, July 17, 2023 at 7:00 p.m.
