Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – November 14, 2023

November 14, 2023 – Special Meeting of Council

- Council approved a Development Variance Permit at 185 Whittlesey Street to vary the side yard property line from 1.2m to 1.02m with additional conditions that the accessory structure's eave does not extend beyond 1.5(3.81cm) from the building wall from the shortest distance measured to the property line and snow guards be installed prior to the issuance of a building permit.
