Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – January 22, 2024

Regular Meeting of Council

- The Kitimat RCMP presented the October, November and December Policing Reports to Council and provided an update on some of their activities in the community.
- Council heard from the Kitimat Valley Naturalists on the disposition of lands to Cedar LNG.
- Council directed staff to explore the addition of a sunset clause into the Covenant Modification Agreement with Cedar LNG, so that if a Final Investment Decision is not made within a reasonable time frame, the agreement expires, and the original covenant is restored without prejudice. Staff will provide a report to Council at a future meeting.
- Council approved Development Permit 01-2024 Amendment Application for a proposed commercial development located at 36 Highway 37. The proposed development includes restaurant with drive-thru, convenience store and gas bar, and a carwash.
- Council approved a grant application for the 2024 Union of BC Municipalities Community Emergency Preparedness, Emergency Support Services Equipment and Training Program. If successful, the grant will provide funding to help build local capacity to provide emergency support services through Emergency Support Services (ESS) volunteers and to purchase equipment needed by ESS when mobilized.
- Council amended and approved the Solid Waste Disposal – Residential Landfill Free Pass Policy to provide the four free landfill passes to each household participating in the Residential Collection Service. The four free landfill passes will be delivered to each household in early February and can be used anytime prior to December 31, 2024. - Council approved a request for the removal of approximately 20.8 m² of trees from 2109 Forest Ave to allow visibility for the McDonald's pylon sign. The applicant is responsible for all costs associated with the removal of the trees and the cutting of the trees is contingent on the sign installation.
