



# Notes from Council

## Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – March 25, 2024

### Regular Meeting of Council

- Following a presentation and a \$50,000 grant request from My Mountain Co-op (Shames Mountain), Council directed staff to provide comment at a future meeting prior to the 2024 budget being finalized.
- Council gave first three readings to Council Procedure Amendment Bylaw No. 2047, 2024. Bylaw No. 2047, 2024 proposed to amend Council procedures related to Council meetings. Notice of the proposed changes will be advertised in the Northern Sentinel and posted to the District website and notice boards. The Bylaw will be brought back for Council consideration of adoption at a future meeting of Council.
- Council approved for consideration a Development Variance Permit Application for 108 Whittlesey. The application is to vary the height of an accessory structure from 4.9 metres to 5.2 metres and vary the rear yard property line from 1.2 metres to 0.0 metres. Public Notice will be posted to the District website and notice boards, and mailed to properties within 30 metres of 108 Whittlesey.
- Council received a presentation from staff on Bill 44 Housing Statutes (Residential Development) Amendment Act, 2023.
- Council supported an application from the Kitimat 50+ Society to the Northern Development Initiative Trust's Community Spaces Grant Program.
- Council approved the landing and take-off of helicopters from Riverlodge Ball Fields as part of the Canada Day Festivities on July 1, 2024. Festivals Kitimat 2024 is in the beginning stages of planning July 1<sup>st</sup> events, and an event schedule will be shared on the District's social media platforms and website soon.
- Council directed staff to undertake a review of Council's Community Grants/Sponsorship Program and provide recommendations on the Program's grant opportunities.
