I am writing to comment on the Temporary use permit for a park and ride lot on 160 Konigus St. I live at 185 Konigus St and I have a major concern with the park and ride lot on my street. I have 4 kids that play outside sometimes on their bikes on the street along with their 4 friends across the street at 196 Konigus St.

I am very concerned about the extra 75 cars each day with tired workers rushing to go home after work. I am a construction worker and know how it feels to want to get home after a long 12 hour shift. Young kids are not always aware of traffic at times and it would be a parent's worst nightmare to have their kid run out and get hit by a car accidentally by a tired worker in a rush to go home to relax. one thing I know about construction workers being one myself is there is always one or two that have no concerns about anyone just jumping into the truck and flooring it down the road.

I realize that space is at a premium in our little town, but I think that using this space is kind of out of the way for workers and we have other places that have been used in the past that don't have small kids playing. When we had the big snowfall in 2015 I was working on the KMP project and I think it was mountain view square as a temporary park and ride. it is empty most of the time and could accommodate 75 cars easily.

What is LGC Flour going to do to make sure this is safe for everyone living on Konigus St ? I will be honest if it goes through we will most likely move. As we all know trying trying to find affordable housing in our town is all in the past now so we will most likely move back down south as house prices are about the same here now. I am all for the LNG project but I think there is lot of unforeseen things like this that affect many in our little town.
