In accordance with section 40 of the *Community Charter*, the District of Kitimat is providing notice of Council's consideration of first three readings of the proposed bylaw. The District of Kitimat invites any persons who considers themselves affected by the proposed bylaw to make representations to Council.

### PURPOSE

The District of Kitimat is proposing to permanently close and remove the road dedication for a portion of the excess boulevard on the east side of Wakashan Avenue (see location map), for the purposes of consolidation with adjacent municipal lands in Mountainview Square.
