Regarding bylaw 1934-461 for rezoning of Quatsino Boulevard.

I am writing this letter to DOK, as I am NOT in favour of the rezoning. We/DOK all made the decision to deny the condo complex that was proposed by the Rigoni brothers at the entrance to Blueberry Avenue. We did not move to the finest subdivision in Kitimat to have not only the city, but individuals wanting to build multi-family complexes, when we are single-family dwelling. We provided DOK with a downtown revitalization plan and this shelter or any other multi-use facility is not what Strawberry Meadows was built for. I am not in favour of this amendment as it will open the door for others to build condos etc and like I said we set precedence, as well the DOK, when the previous builders tried the same thing.

Mountain View Square is the best option and as Mayor and Council it's time to look to the future with a vision for the downtown.
