Hello,

I've confirmed that the operating agreement for the Transition House and Second Stage programs will be a 3 year term. The affordable housing will likely be a 3 year term as well although we could go up to a 5 year term but no longer than that.

We can also state that this funding is a part of Building BC: Women's Transition Housing Fund, a \$734-million investment over 10 years to build and operate 1,500 transition, second-stage and affordable housing spaces for women and children escaping violent situations.

Furthermore, the current Transition House – Dunmore Place has operated with government funding since 1996.

With respect to staffing, the Transition House is staffed 24/7, 365 days/yr this includes a Program Manager and Support Workers. The current funding will transfer to the new site and will include some additional funding for support worker hours. And for the SS and affordable housing, new positions will be required and we're looking at up to 6 new fte's.
