



Kitimat Council is seeking interested individuals to fill volunteer positions on the following:

### **Board of Variance – 1 position**

Members meet as needed to hear appeals from property owners who wish to change property siting requirements set by zoning regulations.

### **Advisory Commission for Persons with Disabilities - 2 positions**

Members meet monthly to discuss ideas for a barrier-free community to help improve the quality of life for all in Kitimat.

#### **Role of the Commission:**

- Advise Council on matters presently under consideration which affect those with a disability
- Monitor District programs to ensure that the needs of those with a disability are considered
- Work cooperatively with District departments, Boards, and Commissions whose activities affect those with disabilities and to provide advice and information
- Encourage and facilitate feedback through existing channels from those with disabilities on civic matters affecting them
- Bring to Council matters identified by the Commission as requiring action by the District
- Deal with any matters concerning those with disabilities which may be referred to the Committee by Council

### **Energy, Emissions and Solid Waste Advisory Committee – 10 positions**

Members meet a minimum of three times per year with additional meetings held on an as required basis.

#### **Role of the Commission:**

- To provide informed recommendations identified by staff and/or Council and related to the matters of the Community Energy and Emissions Plan (CEEP) and the Solid Waste Management Strategy Action Plan (SWAP).

### **Advisory Planning Commission – 1 position**

Members meet on an as needed basis.

#### **Role of the Commission:**

- Help guide the long-term development of your community.
- Receive input from residents and advice from professional planners.
- Make recommendations and advise Council on such matters as: community plans; development control; future land use; proposed policies or bylaws respecting residential, commercial, institutional, and industrial development; and various types of development applications.

### **Leisure Services Advisory Commission – 1 position**

Members meet monthly from September to June to discuss and make recommendations on issues affecting Kitimat's recreational needs.

#### **Role of the Commission:**

- Receive input from the community.
- Make recommendations to Council.
- Provide recommendations to the Leisure Services Department.
- Recommend major expenditures or policy changes that will make a significant and positive change in the Leisure Services Department direction or its operations.
- Provide direction and guidance on policy and practices for the betterment of the community and the achievement of Council's purpose and goals.
