### **Board of Variance – 1 position**

Members meet as needed to hear appeals from property owners who wish to change property siting requirements set by zoning regulations.

#### **Role of the Commission:**

- Be able to appreciate community and neighbourhood aesthetics
- Be able to read construction drawings
- Have good knowledge of building procedures and materials

### **Advisory Commission for Persons with Disabilities - 4 positions**

Members meet monthly to discuss ideas for a barrier-free community to help improve the quality of life for all in Kitimat.

#### **Role of the Commission:**

- To advise Council on matters presently under consideration which affect those with a disability.
- To monitor District programs to ensure that the needs of those with a disability are considered.
- To work cooperatively with District departments, Boards, and Commissions whose activities affect those with disabilities and to provide advice and information to them.
- To encourage and facilitate feedback through existing channels from those with disabilities on civic matters affecting them.
- To bring to Council matters identified by the Commission as requiring action by the District.
- To deal with any matters concerning those with disabilities which may be referred to the Committee by council.

### **Energy, Emissions and Solid Waste Advisory Committee – 10 positions**

***Please note: the deadline to apply to this committee is December 14<sup>th</sup>, 2022.***

Members meet a minimum of three times per year with additional meetings held on an as required basis.

#### **Role of the Commission:**

- To provide informed recommendations identified by staff and/or Council and related to the matters of the Community Energy and Emissions Plan (CEEP) and the Solid Waste Management Strategy Action Plan (SWAP).

### **Advisory Planning Commission – 1 position**

Members meet on an as needed basis.

#### **Role of the Commission:**

- Help guide the long-term development of your community.
- Receive input from residents and advice from professional planners.
- Make recommendations and advise Council on such matters as: community plans; development control; future land use; proposed policies or bylaws respecting residential, commercial, institutional, and industrial development; and various types of development applications.
