MASKS MANDATE UPDATED

October 4, 2021 – By order of the Provincial Health Officer, starting on Friday October 1, all visitors to municipal facilities who are 9 years of age or older must wear masks while in indoor public spaces. Previously, the mask requirement was in place for people aged 12 years and older.

There are exemptions for:

- People with health conditions or with physical, cognitive, or mental impairments who cannot wear one
- People who cannot remove a mask on their own
- Children under the age of 9
- People who need to remove their masks to communicate due to another person's hearing impairment

Masks may be removed temporarily in indoor public places to:

- Identify the individual wearing the mask
- Consume food or beverage at a location designated for this purpose
- Participate in a sport or fitness activity (masks must be worn when not engaged in physical activity)
