Festivals Kitimat plans are almost complete, as we are just over a week away from the Canada Day Celebration in Kitimat!

On Friday, June 21nd is the Annual Show and Shine from 6 pm to 10 pm over at the Tamitik Arena

On Saturday June 22nd is the 11th Annual Memorial Hill Climb. Time Trials starting at 10:00am

On Friday June 28th at the Tamitik Arena is the 54.40 concert. Doors open at 6 pm with the show starting at 6:30 pm. The opening bands include; Miss Demeanor and Strange Ways, with the main act being 54.40 and closing the show will be The Rats.

There will be a free bus service starting at 10 am to 6 pm on July 1st. We are encouraging people to walk, bike or take advantage of the free bus service on Canada Day to enjoy the festivities down at City Centre as parking will be limited.

Start celebrating your Canada Day at the upper City Centre Mall on July 1st from 8-11 am by enjoying a pancake breakfast. Then at noon the annual Kinsmen Club of Kitimat Canada Day parade will be leaving from Riverlodge and ending at Mountainview Square with plenty of floats, marchers and vehicles decorated in this year's theme "Canadian Music".

At the upper city centre mall in front of the PF Pizzeria & Bistro will be a beer gardens starting at noon.

At the lower city centre mall parking lot starting at 11am you will find Food and Craft Vendors at our International Food and Craft Fair as well as the stage show, beginning at 1:15 pm. At the Lion's Park from 1 pm to 4 pm is the Kid's Fun Zone, cake walk, bouncy castle and more taking place in the surrounding area. At 2 pm until 7 pm everyone's favorite Helicopter rides will be taking off from the Mountainview Square parking lot - \$50 per person. As well, head inside the upper city centre mall at 1:00pm to watch the diaper derby then enjoy a delicious piece of Canada Day cake handed out by the Girl Guides of Canada at 2pm in the lower city centre mall.

The Free Swim will take place from 4-7 pm at the Sam Lindsay Aquatic Centre.

Finally, come back and finish your day off at 11 pm at Riverlodge with a fantastic Fireworks display put on by the Kitimat Fire Department.
