

Air Curtain Incinerator

Guidance for use in B.C. under the open burning smoke control regulation

What is an Air Curtain Incinerator?

Air curtain incinerator is a device that is designed to aid in combustion and reduce emissions by directing a flow of air across the (a) open chamber in the device, or (b) trench.

Other names are ACI, Burn Box or Air Curtain Burner.

Forced air/fans are **not** an ACI.

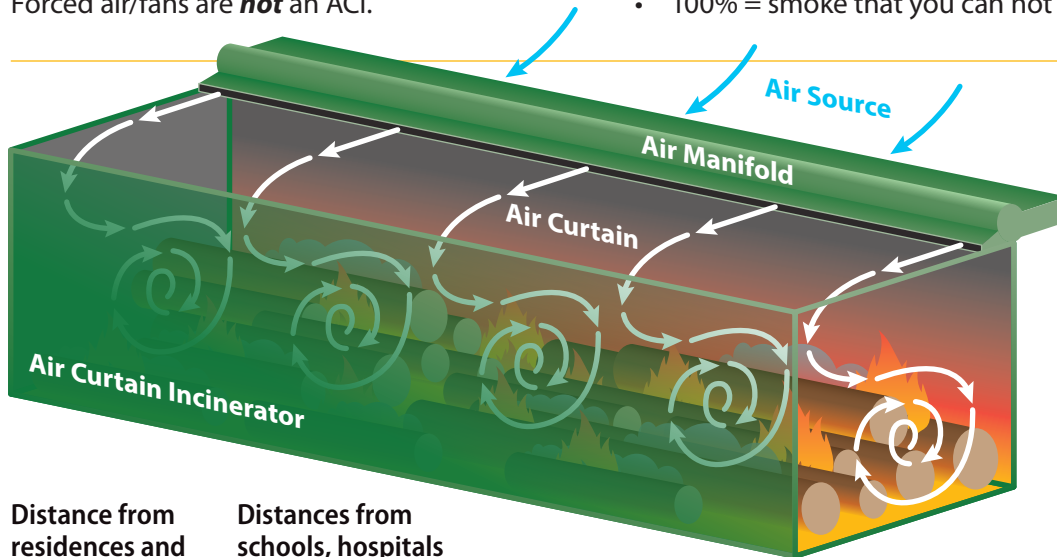
Opacity Explained

Opacity may be 40% during the 30 minute start-up period and then must not exceed 15% for more than 5 minutes during any other 30 minute period.

- 0% = no visible smoke
- 15% = transparent, barely visible smoke
- **40% = smoke that you can see through**
- 100% = smoke that you can not see through

Useful Tip!

Material does not need to be seasoned when using an ACI.
