Ventilation index:                         <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) <b>"good"</b> for the day the open burning starts, and</li> <li>(b) <b>"good"</b> or <b>"fair"</b> for the second day of the open burning.</li> <li>(c) the open burning starts not earlier than one hour after sunrise;</li> <li>(d) unlit piles of the vegetative debris are ignited, and remaining unlit vegetative debris is added to the ignited piles of the vegetative debris, only during the period that starts one hour after sunrise and ends 4 hours before sunset on the day the open burning starts;</li> <li>(e) the open burning ends by 4 p.m. on the second day of the open burning.</li> </ol> </li> <li>8. The permittee, <b>shall</b> ensure the material to be burned is a minimum of <b>12 meters</b> from standing timber, brush or other flammable materials.                      The permittee shall provide at the site during light up and duration of the burn, the following staff and equipment for patrolling and preventing the escape of the fire authorized by this permit.</li> <li>9. _____ Adult person(s) equipped with tools to safeguard the fire.</li> <li>10.
