## Kitimat Council Meeting Summary of Key Items – September 3, 2024

### Regular Meeting of Council

- Council received a presentation from the Skeena Roundtable.
- Council adopted Public Notice Advertising Bylaw No. 2055, 2024.
- Council gave first three readings to the District of Kitimat Water Treatment System Loan Authorization Bylaw No.2058, 2024. This bylaw would enable the District to borrow up to \$13,500,000. for the Water Treatment Upgrade Project. Bylaw No. 2058, 2024 will be brought back for Council consideration of adoption at a future meeting. - Council gave first three readings to the District of Kitimat Northwest BC Regional Funding Agreement Reserve Fund Bylaw No.2056, 2024.
- Council authorized the Mayor and Corporate Officer to execute the District's License of Occupation and Management Plan for land in the vicinity of Clague Mountain and Bowbyes Creek.
- Council authorized comments be submitted to the BC Energy Regulator that the District of Kitimat does not object to Coastal GasLink's Phase 2 Kitimat Sales Meter Station Amendment and will request consideration of the impacts for additional traffic to municipal roads.
- Council endorsed the hiring of an environmental consultant to look at the impacts of potential quarry activities at Clague Mountain.
- Council requested that the Tamitik facility be lit up purple for the month of September to highlight Literacy Month.
- As a result of two letters from businesses in the service centre, Council agreed to refer the paving of 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue to budget discussions.
