Winter Parking

Over the winter (from Nov 1 to March 31) RVs, boats, and trailers can be parked on a residential property provided that they are:

- 4.5 metres (~15') back from the front property line; or
- Located on your legal driveway, maximum width 7.5 metres (~24' 6"), behind the front property line; and
- One side yard of at least 1.8 metres (~6') is unobstructed

Q. What is a recreational vehicle?

A. A Recreational Vehicle, or RV, is defined as a portable structure designed and built to be carried on a vehicle, or a unit designed and built to be transported on its own wheels to provide temporary living accommodation for travel and recreational purposes and includes vehicles such as a motor home, fifth wheel, camper, travel trailer, and tent trailer.

Q. What vehicles can I park or store on my lot?

A. On a residential lot you can park one RV, and two boats or trailers under 6.5 metres (~ 21' 4") in length, and up to three motor vehicles.

Q. When are winter parking restrictions in place?

A. Winter parking restrictions are in effect from November 1 to March 31 to protect space for snow clearing operations.

Q. When are summer parking restrictions in place?

A. Summer parking restrictions are in effect from April 1 to October 31. During the summer RVs may be parked on the driveway provided they are behind the front property line. RVs are not permitted to be parked on the street.

Ammonia Leak Drill

In an effort to be proactive with our procedures and emergency responders, there will be an ammonia leak drill at the Tamitik Jubilee Sports Complex on November 20th between 10 am and noon.

This will be treated like an actual emergency and there will be emergency vehicles outside of Tamitik.

Ammonia is used as a refrigerant in both of our arenas. Although a leak is extremely rare, it is necessary to know what to do and practice the evacuation procedure in the event of an actual leak.



This is only a drill, so don't be alarmed.
